### About this Web Site

The Sensor Technology Information Exchange will improve communication among sensor developers, vendors, and users inside and outside the environmental arena. It serves as a forum for exchanging information on sensor technologies and needs. Although this site is designed as a tool to assist the environmental field with hazardous waste cleanup, it includes information on sensors from divergent but related technical fields—medical monitoring instruments, aerospace, electronic, transportation, telecommunications, and natural resource development remote sensing—because sensors from one field may be applied in another field.

The Sensor Technology Information Exchange is funded through a cooperative agreement between WPI, a not-for-profit corporation affiliated with Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.


# Match-Making Tools

The Submit and Search functions within the Sensor Technology Information Exchange can help play match maker between users looking for a sensor technology to meet a specific need and vendors and developers who have a commercially-available sensor or who are developing a sensor that could meet that need. Vendors and developers from all sensor fields can submit information about their sensors to the database, and users can use keywords to search the entries.

The Discussion Forum also serves as a match maker among developers, vendors, and users. The topics of discussion on the forum are not limited—it is intended to meet the individual needs of all web site users.

The Sensor Technology Information Exchange also contains a Calendar of Events and News and Links pages. These features serve as communication tools for the sensor technology community. Visitors to the web site can access these pages to obtain information on events, news, and sources of related information, or to submit events, news, and links.
