Biographical Note

Deborah J. Kuhlmann, Ph.D., taught as a lecturer for Texas A&M Galveston for almost 20 years from 1986 until 2004. Her full time position during those years was as a Professor of English at Galveston College. Kuhlmann completed her Ph.D. in English at Texas Christian University in 1985. Other degrees she holds include anM.A. from the University of Arkansas and a B.A. from Texas Christian University. Her desire for travel and a strong commitment to international education resulted in what she considered a highlight of her career by gaining the chance to both teach and sail aboard the *Texas Clipper*, Texas A&M University's College-on-the-Sea, where she taught English Composition and Rhetoric. Additionally, Kuhlmann took a sabbatical during 1993 -1994 to teach at Egerton University in Kenya.

That said, she said then and continues to say there was just nothing like the *Texas Clipper*. It was the intersection of academics, tradition, community, and adventure, a unique chapter in both the educational history of TAMUG as well as that of the United States.

Her time aboard the *Texas Clipper* sealed her loyalty as a sea Aggie, as A&M became clearly in that sense one of her academic homes. Her tenure included: The summer of 1989 as Lecturer, aboard the *Texas Clipper*, Texas A&M University's College-on-the-Sea Cruise to Portugal and Spain The summer of 1990 as Lecturer, aboard the *Texas Clipper*, Texas A&M University's College-on-the-Sea Cruise to Northern Europe The summer of 1991 as Lecturer, aboard the *Texas Clipper*, Texas A&M University's

College-on-the-Sea Caribbean Cruise

During her career Kuhlmann received exceptional service awards and presented several dozen conference papers and published over one dozen articles, including reference materials on topics in both British and American literature and in both African American and women's literature. Her research interests gravitated toward epiphanies and epistemological themes in fiction as well as poetry. She ultimately went on to retire from the University of Houston Clear Lake.
