INTRODUCTION

This collection of papers of Frank G. Malik documents some of his career as a chemical engineer with Mobil Oil Company in Beaumont, his service in the Naval Reserve, 8th District, New Orleans, LA, and as a leader and organizer of Boy Scouts at the Longfellow School in Beaumont, Texas. The Williams library received the collection as a gift.

Malik was born on October 1, 1917 and died on July 21 1995. The papers in this collection document his life in Beaumont, Texas. He worked for Mobil Oil Corporation as a project engineer at the Beaumont refinery. Addresses on journals show Malik living at 190 E. Circuit Drive, Beaumont, TX until 1955. At that time, a change of address shows his residence to be 3420 Durwood, Beaumont, TX. The Longfellow School where he worked with various Boy Scout troops was at 3395 Harrison Avenue in Beaumont. It was built in 1950. The school subsequently became known as the Wellbanks School and since 1986 has housed the Beaumont Independent School District administration building.

SCOPE and CONTENTS

The collection is approximately two linear feet in size and contains items dating from 1949 to 1968. The collection is divided into six series: 1. Incoming correspondence; 2. Civil Career – chemical engineer; 3. Boy scouts of America; 4. United States Navy; 5. Publications; and 6. Photographs.

Series 3: Boy Scouts of America is further subdivided into four subseries: A. National; B. Trinity District; C. Trinity-Neches Council; D. Beaumont, TX. **Series 4**: United States Navy is subdivided into three subseries: A. Reserves; B. Courses & Seminars (B.1. Navy War College-correspondence course; B.2. West Coast Ordnance Seminar; B.3. BUWEPS Naval Weapons Course; B.4. Weapons Development and Test Course); and **Series 5**: Publications into five subseries: A. Journals; B. Newsletters; C. Pamphlets/Brochures; D. Monographs; E. Maps.

The organization of Boy Scout troops sponsored by the PTA of Longfellow School in Beaumont, Texas in 1958 is detailed with names and addresses of troop members. There are numerous documents related to the correspondence course in strategy and tactics which Malik took from the Naval War College in 1958. Incoming correspondence is related to his service as a Boy Scout troop leader, his service in the Naval Reserves, and one letter from the President of the Naval War College, Vice ADM S.H. Ingersoll. Included in Series 5: Publications are numerous journals from the Navy. Series 6: Photographs include two group photographs taken while at various Navy Reserve training seminars.

Series 1: Correspondence – Incoming 8 folders 1958-1959 Box 1

Correspondence is arranged chronologically. Includes correspondence related to the administration of the Boy Scouts of America local troops at the Longfellow School in Beaumont, TX. Malik was instrumental in organizing the troops along with the local PTA as the sponsoring organization. Also included is correspondence related to his service in the Naval Reserve and the correspondence course which he took through the Naval War College. Three blank postal cards with the imprint of the U.S. Navy are included.

Series 2: Civil Career – Chemical Engineer **2 folders 1958, 1960 Box 1**

Includes position vacancy with Standard-Vacuum Oil Company, White Plains, NY and a job questionnaire for MP-MPLCO (Mobile Pipe Line Co.). Arranged by date.

Series 3: Boy Scouts of America

Box 1

Arranged in four subseries: A. National; B. Trinity District; C. Trinity-Neches Council; D. Beaumont, TX. Within each subseries, arranged chronologically. Documents date from the late 1950s to the early 1960s. This series documents the organization and applications for Troops 3, 333, and Pack Troop 3003 at Longfellow School in Beaumont, TX. Also included is *Boys' Life* subscription information for Troup 2003 and a speech by Malik to community leaders introducing C.H. Homer, Jr.

Arranged in three subseries: A. Reserves; B. Courses and Seminars; C. Certificates. Within each subseries, arranged chronologically. Malik was assigned to the 8th Naval District, New Orleans, LA. Included is his application for active duty training; materials related to a correspondence course in strategy and tactics which he took through the Naval War College, various other training and seminars in naval weaponry. Box 6 contains the oversized maps and charts related to the correspondence course in strategy. Subseries C includes certificates he received upon completion of various courses.

Arranged in five subseries: A. Journals; B. Newsletters; C. Pamphlets & Brochures; D. Monographs; E. Maps. Within each subseries arranged alphabetically. The journals are primarily related to the Navy and Naval Reserve. The newsletters are from various organizations:

American Ordnance Association, University of Texas at Austin, Magnolia Petroleum Co., and Republic National Bank of Dallas. The pamphlets and brochures are primarily from California and related to the San Diego area when Malik attended Naval Reserve training. The monographs include catalog of correspondence courses from the Naval War College and a publication on chemical and biological agents and weapons. One hand drawn map of the US Naval Air Station, North Island, San Diego, CA is included. Maps and charts related to the course in strategy and tactics are found in Series 4.
