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ABSTRACT

: In order to inform Comprehensive Local and State Planners
and other data users of the nature and extent of Public
Information collected by Texas State Agencies, a survey
of Texas State Agencies was made. The results of the
survey are included in this, "Survey of Statistical and
Planning Data Collected by Texas State Agencies." This
publication is intended as a guide to data and information
sources within Texas State Government. The data referenced
includes county, city and state statistics on population,
income, employment, vital statistics, agricultural, manu-
facturing, mining and business production and value added.

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P R E F A C E

The conduct of Public Business at all levels of Government, Comprehensive Planning, and Research to serve planning require technical, social, and economic data. Texas State Commissions, Agencies, Boards and Departments, in fulfillment of their normal duties, collect and maintain, at considerable cost, files of data needed to carry out individual agency programs.

Many of the data collected by individual State agencies are also useful and usable by other State Agencies, Local Agencies, Federal Agencies, Planners and Researchers at all levels of Government. The efficacy of coordinated sharing of that portion of data which is public information is clear. There is saving in both time and funds if more than one use is made of collected data. If more than one entity uses data collected by a single or primary data collector, the number and expense of impositions upon data suppliers, usually private individuals and private businesses, is reduced. In addition, a coordinated and specialized program to obtain data required for Planning, Research, and Administration of State Government Programs will permit improved quality of data bases available for a multiplicity of uses through standardization of sampling procedures and collection methods, standardization of file maintenance and updating, and readily justifies the use of specialists trained in scientific data collection methods and procedures.

In order to inform Comprehensive Local and State Planners and other data users of the nature and extent of Public Information collected

by Texas State Agencies, a survey of Texas State Agencies was made. The results of the survey are included in this, "Survey of Statistical and Planning Data Collected by Texas State Agencies." This publication is intended as a guide to data and information sources within Texas State Government. Requests for information and arrangements to secure data should be made directly to the Agency listed as having the data. In many instances it may be necessary for the individual users to perform the actual clerical tasks of securing the desired data, since individual agencies do not necessarily have sufficient staff to conduct this type of work. In all cases, arrangements to obtain data from the sources listed herein should be made well in advance of the anticipated date the data are needed.

This report was prepared as a part of the Texas Interindustry Project -- a joint project funded by the Planning Agency Council for Texas, the Office of the Governor, and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, under the provisions of Section 701 of the Housing Act of 1954 as amended.

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1. OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

- 1.001 TEXAS INTERINDUSTRY PROJECT. (Estimated completion date August 1971). Population and Economics Task Force Project of Planning Agency Council for Texas to develop nine regional and a statewide Input-Output Model of Texas Economic structure from sample survey and secondary data.
- 1.002 FIVE-DIGIT ZIP CODE AREA DATA. published 1966. Population and income data from individual income tax returns to the Internal Revenue Service.
- 1.003 COMMUNITY PROFILE PROJECT. published by the Office of Economic Opportunity. The Community Profile Project is an extensive inventory of current and historical data maintained by the Community Profile Project of the Office of Economic Opportunity which describes the social and economic characteristics of the United States at a county level. The Profile contains reports showing general poverty indicators, size and composition of the poor population, and selected aspects of the geography, demography, economy and social resources of each county in Texas.
- 1.004 FEDERAL OUTLAYS IN TEXAS. published annually, by the Office of Economic Opportunity. Data are summarized at the National and State levels by agency, program, and budget function.
- 1.005 MARKET IDENTIFIERS - DUN AND BRADSTREET. Information on tape. Individual data on Texas establishments. Tape includes business name, street address, mail address, physical location of the establishment, telephone number, year started, credit rating, size indicators and standard industrial classification number.
- 1.006 CATALOG OF WATER ORIENTED DATA. published 1970. compiled by the Interagency Natural Resources Council. Water oriented data catalog which for the first time clearly enumerates what kind of specific water and related data are available and being collected where they can be obtained, and in what form.
- 1.007 TEXAS GULF COAST. November 1969. Annotated bibliography identifying current and past studies of the Texas Coastal resources. Information is coded on cards and can be selected by individual river basin, planning region, and resource.

Tables, charts, and graphs of deaths by: (1) residence, of deceased by State, county, and city (2,500 - up); (2) month; (3) race and sex; (4) age; (5) marital status; (6) hospital or home; (7) cause of death; (8) autopsy; and (9) physician or other.
- 7.010 TEXAS VITAL STATISTICS - FETAL DEATHS (STILLBIRTHS). published annually. (series data 1933 to present). Tables, charts and graphs of fetal deaths by (1) residence of mother by State, county, and city (2,500 - up); (2) month; (3) race and sex; (4) age of mother; (5) plurality; (6) birth order; (7) legitimacy status; (8) hospital or home delivery; (9) physician or midwife delivery; (10) period of gestation; (11) weight; and (13) autopsy.
- 7.011 TEXAS VITAL STATISTICS - BIRTHS. published annually. (series data 1933 to present). Tables, charts and graphs of births by (1) residence of mother by State, county, and city (2,500 - up); (2) month; (3) race and sex; (4) age of mother; (5) plural births; (6) birth order; (7) legitimacy status; (8) hospital or home delivery; (9) physician or midwife delivery; (10) period of gestation; (11) birth weight; (12) prenatal care; and (13) congenital abnormality.
- 7.012 TEXAS VITAL STATISTICS - MARRIAGES. published annually. (series data 1966 to present). Tables, charts, graphs of marriages by (1) county of marriage; (2) race and age of groom; (3) race and age of bride; (4) county of application for marriage license; and (5) month of marriage.

- 7.013 DIVORCE DATA. Tables, charts and graphs of divorces and annulments by (1) county of divorce or annulment; (2) race and age of husband; (3) race and age of wife; (4) length of marriage; (6) number of children; (7) plaintiff; and (8) month of divorce.
- 7.014 LOCAL HEALTH SERVICES. unpublished, compiled monthly. (series data 1943 to present). Tables of data concerning communicable disease control, home health services, tuberculosis control, maternity services, child health services, dental health services, general sanitation services, and food and milk sanitation services, adult health services, cancer control services, and other chronic disease services.

8. TEXAS HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

- 8.001 BIENNIAL REPORT. published every two years. This report covers, in general, the various activities of the Texas Highway Department. Information includes Departments' general balance sheets, summary statements, cash receipts and disbursements, summary of construction projects started and completed - showing mileage and costs, summary of types of mileage under maintenance, summary of regular maintenance and traffic service cost, and summary of equipment operating cost.
- 8.002 ROAD, STREET AND HIGHWAY FINANCE FACTS. published August, 1966. (series data 1950 to present). Bi-annual report of source of revenues and purpose of expenditures for all Texas Highway agencies in road construction and maintenance.
- 8.003 MOTOR FUEL CONSUMPTION AND TAXATION REPORT. published monthly. (series data 1936 to present). Tables containing amount of tax collections and number of gallons taxed and dollars refunded on all motor fuels.
- 8.004 LOCAL FINANCE REPORT. published annually. (series data 1936 to present). Tables of road and street receipts, disbursements and debt, in all cities and counties by assessed value or population groups.
- 8.005 TRAFFIC VOLUME MAPS. published annually. (series data 1946 to present). Maps showing annual average 24-hour traffic volumes for all types of vehicles, on the State highways, county roads, and city streets in the State of Texas.
- 8.006 TRAFFIC FLOW MAPS. published 1967. A pictorial map showing annual average 24-hour traffic volumes for all types of vehicles on State highways by scaled flow bandwidths.

- 8.007 TRAFFIC RECORDER RECORD AND MONTHLY PERCENT VARIATIONS. published monthly. (series data 1964 to present). Charts and graphs containing traffic data consisting of hourly volumes at permanent traffic recorder locations throughout Texas, including a summary of hourly volumes and a graph of monthly variations in traffic volumes giving monthly comparison for three year period.
- 8.008 TRUCK WEIGHT AND VEHICLE CLASSIFICATION STUDY. published annually. (series data 1946 to present). A series of tables showing, by highway system, summary information relative to truck classification, gross loads, axle loads, axle spacing, frequency of loaded and empty trucks, commodity carried and the average carried loads.
- 8.009 EXTERNAL ORIGIN-DESTINATION TRAFFIC STUDIES. compiled at irregular intervals. A selected list of detailed reports on traffic movements by vehicle types entering and leaving a municipality presented in tabular and graphical form.
- 8.010 REGISTRATION YEAR COMPARATIVE REPORT. unpublished, compiled monthly. (series data 1960 to present). Comparison of current year vehicle registrations with the previous year's totals by vehicle classes. Also, shows increase or decrease in number of registrations. Report prepared monthly on a "year to date" basis, by registration year (April 1 - March 31).
- 8.011 DISTRIBUTION OF REGISTRATION FEES BETWEEN COUNTIES AND STATE. unpublished, compiled annually. (series data 1949 to present). Summary statement showing distribution of registration fees between the counties and the State Highway Department, together with the number of vehicles registered in each county. (registration year basis - April 1 - March 31.)
- 8.012 FISCAL YEAR MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION REPORT. unpublished, compiled annually. (series data 1930 to present). Tables showing motor vehicle registrations by classes of vehicles, gross fees for counties and the State Highway Department, average fees for classes of registration, and net license fees to the State Highway Department. (Fiscal year basis - Sept. 1 - Aug. 31.)
- 8.013 LICENSE PLATES ASSIGNED TO THE COUNTY TAX COLLECTORS. published annually. (series data 1917 to present). List of the license plates allotted to each of the 254 County Tax Collectors for the purpose of registering motor vehicles owned by residents of their respective counties.

8.015 ROAD LIFE STUDY. unpublished, compiled annually. (series data 1936 to present). Data related to highway construction location, design, components, and to expenditures. RECORD OF HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION AND COSTS ON HIGHWAYS OR SECTIONS OF HIGHWAYS DESIGNATED AS FOREST HIGHWAYS. published annually. (series data 1957 to present). A listing of the mileage constructed and money expended and the amount of money remaining.

8.017 ROAD, STREET AND HIGHWAY FINANCE. unpublished, compiled annually. (series data 1936 to present). Tables that present the interdependent financial facts of all agencies concerned in highway finance for all systems.

8.018 REGIONAL AND/OR METROPOLITAN AREA TRAFFIC SURVEYS. published at irregular intervals. This report contains results and findings in tabular and graphic form of factual data obtained from a comprehensive origin-destination survey, including vehicles, persons and commodities and land use within and through the survey area.

8.019 SPEED SURVEY. published annually. (series data 1962 to present). A series of tables showing, by vehicle type, the percent exceeding 35MPH to 75MPH in 5MPH increments, median slow or 15 percentile speed.
