## PARTNERSHIP

- Galveston Island Park Board
  - Creates content, selects outside resources
- Texas A&M – Galveston, Jack K. Williams Library
  - Collects & organizes content
  - Provides access (metadata, hosting)
- Texas Digital Library
  - Provides support to TAMUG Library
  - Guidance & direction for growth

## TEXAS DIGITAL LIBRARY (TDL)

- Academic library consortium (2005)
  - Resource sharing, digital library infrastructure
- Texas A&M – Galveston's membership:
  - Digital repository & storage space for several digital collections
  - Technical support, training, ongoing help
  - Monthly conference call about Beach Management Data project

## PROGRESS TO DATE

- December 2013: initial meeting between TAMUG & Galveston Island Park Board
- January 2014: TAMUG & Park Board meet to set scope and purpose of the repository
  - Park Board provides small set of documents to get repository started
- February 2014: TAMUG and TDL begin ongoing discussions of the project
- March 2014: Initial load of 33 documents into Beach Management Information Portal <https://repositories.tdl.org/tamug-ir/handle/1969.3/28468>

## NEXT STEPS

- Usability testing; seek feedback
- Ongoing: Loading of additional material from Park Board
- Share portal with other stakeholders
  - E.g. homeowners' associations
- Unique look & feel
- More "web-like" search feature

## NEXT STEPS

- Expand partnerships
  - Other Galveston-area entities
  - Park Boards in other areas
- Ultimately, aiming for a nationwide reach
