Advice From One Of the OCLC WMS SUSHI Harvest Users in the Country

- Be patient.
 - Sending out 600 SUSHI calls → if something's not working quite right, you get 600 errors.
- Iteration is your friend.
 - Maybe treat COUNTER emails as a reminder to check up on your harvester; add a setup; go in & fix a thing or two each month.
- GET STARTED!
 - Anything you get done is better than the nothing you started with.
